- ❖ **Proposed Exception Process for Starting Courses Prior to Catalog Publication:** At the January 23rd meeting, CCC discussed a proposed exception process to address instances in which actions by an outside entity, such as accreditation or C-ID, affect a course in ways that are beyond our local control. The proposal also addresses circumstances in which an argument can be made for course changes to be implemented early due to their effect on student success, such as the creation of a new course required for an ADT.
