- ❖ **Associate in Science Degree:** On June 1st, CCC approved an application for a new AS Degree in Biochemistry, which will be sent to the FHDA Board of Trustees for approval at an upcoming meeting.
  
- ❖ **Certificate of Achievement:** On June 1st, CCC approved an application for a new Certificate of Achievement in Data Analytics, which will be sent to the FHDA Board of Trustees for approval at an upcoming meeting.
  
- ❖ **Guided Pathways Mapping Approval Process:** At the June 1st meeting, CCC held a second read of the Guided Pathways Program Map Approval Process. During the discussion, concerns were raised about some of the terminology used in the document, as well as about references to the process for creating Program Maps, which itself has not been formalized.
