- ❖ **Equity in the COR - Why and How:** At the March 12th meeting, CCC approved this document, which condenses our Guiding Principles for Equitable CORs document into something more digestible, providing the “why” and “how” of incorporating equity into six sections of the COR. - ❖ **Updating Foothill GE:** On March 12th, CCC reviewed and approved a document outlining the group’s recommendations for the new Foothill GE pattern, which are based on CCC’s extensive discussions as well as feedback received from folks outside the committee. - ❖ **Resolution to Extend Student Graduation Petition Deadline:** Also during the March 12th meeting, CCC held a second read of this resolution. After thoughtful consideration, the group decided not to take a vote on the resolution and instead approved the creation of a subcommittee for further discussion on the topic. The subcommittee will explore how the college can better ensure students are fully aware of the opportunities they have to receive a degree or certificate, as well as ways to improve and streamline the petition process. The subcommittee will present its recommendations to CCC during spring quarter. If you’re interested in participating, please reach out to Ben.
