❖ **Streamlining Student Graduation Petition Process:** The main topic of discussion at the May 28th CCC meeting was a follow-up to a resolution discussed by CCC during winter quarter (refer to the March 1st & 14th communiqués for details). Andy Lee (CCC rep from the Counseling division) provided a detailed explanation of the processes currently used by Foothill to identify and support students who are nearing completion of a degree or certificate, which included a look at the DegreeWorks software. Andy also shared the many different ways in which he and others in Counseling are working with folks across campus to provide proactive support to students as they near completion, and answered questions from the group.
