**Update on Revision of LIBR 10 COR using the ACRL Framework**

Micaela received examples of the ACRL Framework being integrated in the COR of information literacy courses at other CCCs. Mary shared her proposed revisions to the LIBR 10 COR, we compared it to Micaela's initial mapping of the Standards to the Framework, and discussed steps for getting this going through the curriculum approval process.

**ACTION ITEM:** Will propose over email by next Wednesday, March 27, possible suggestions of mapping the ACRL Framework to COR A.c.i. and E.b, E.d., and E.e.

**ACTION ITEM:** Look at assessment area of COR as place to incorporate ACRL Frame "Scholarship as Conversation."

**ACTION ITEM:** Address requirements in GE Application Area 7 for multiculturalism.

**ACTION ITEM:** Consider replacing title of LIBR 10, "Research Paper Search Strategies," with something more accessible to students. Research other options. Also consider revising description.

**Credit by Exam**

The College Curriculum Committee has been discussing the process for submitting a course to be included in the list of Credit by Exam courses published in the college catalog. Do we want LIBR 10 to be included in this list? It could make the course more attractive, but it would require creating an exam and possibly impose an unfair workload on adjunct instructors. We will continue discussing in the Spring.
