

ON-CAMPUS ASFC 2024-2025 ELECTIONS POSTING POLICY REMINDERS

It's ASFC election season and candidates are busy campaigning! Online voting will begin on Monday, April 29, 2024, and conclude on Wednesday, May 1. Campaigning begins the week prior to the elections.

During this time, the campus posting policy will be modified to accommodate election materials.

Campus Center (Building 2000)

No approval stamp is needed. Students may post anywhere in the Campus Center, with the exception of the following: NO POSTING ON any wood surfaces, painted surfaces, windows/doors and bathroom walls and stalls.

Main Campus

An approval stamp is not needed for fliers designed or printed in the ASFC Design Center with the ASFC logo, no approval stamp is needed. Materials may NOT be posted on any painted or wood surfaces, trees, or lampposts. No lawn signage is allowed. Posting is prohibited on the footbridge as it obstructs vehicle traffic. Students may request to post on division/department boards and approval is at the discretion of the supervising administrator.

Classroom Announcements

Candidates may request to make classroom announcements, either in person, or online. Approval is REQUIRED by the instructor and is at the discretion of the individual faculty member.

Chalk Art on sidewalks is Prohibited.

All material must be removed by Friday, May 3.
