Charge for the Ad-Hoc SLO Workgroup

The Ad-Hoc Student Learning Outcomes (SLO) Workgroup is tasked with developing a faculty-driven, inclusive, and adaptable framework for evaluating and improving student learning outcomes. This framework should:

- 1. **Evaluate Historical and any Current Practices**: Assess SLO processes to identify strengths, challenges, and areas for improvement.
- 2. **Promote Professional Development**: Design opportunities for faculty collaboration and learning to refine SLOs and teaching practices.
- 3. **Foster Continuous Improvement**: Ensure the framework remains responsive to pedagogical changes, institutional priorities, and diverse student needs.
- 4. **Define Key Roles**: Establish the responsibilities and scope of the SLO Coordinator in supporting and guiding the SLO process.
- 5. **Engage Students**: Incorporate feedback mechanisms, such as surveys or panels, to ensure SLOs align with student success and learning experiences.
- 6. **Ensure Transparency and Inclusivity**: Develop processes that value faculty contributions, maintain accountability through a public-facing summary reflection and respect confidentiality with a separation of the internal-facing discussions and external summary documentation.

The workgroup will deliver its recommendations and framework in time for the April 7, 2025, Academic Senate Meeting.
