Review & Approve meeting minutes: 3/13/2017

Meeting Minutes approved. No changes.

Update: Financial Aid: College Cost Comparison (Kevin Harral)

Kevin reviewed drafts of the following documents and the TWG made updates.

- 1) College Cost Comparison handout
- 2) Award Letter
- College Cost Comparison: Add a UC and a WUE school
- Award Letter: Make it a simple handout for students

- Documents will be updated and sent to Cleve. Once documents are finalized they will be uploaded to the Financial Aid website and emailed to students.

College Track (Marshall Lott)

- College Track is going through employment transitions

- Marshall shared discussion with Cleve on how Foothill and College Track can collaborate.

- 1. Create conference call appointments with College Track staff, student, and Foothill Counselors during May or June.
- 50 high school students will be graduating, conduct a presentation on "Transition to College" to their Summer Bridge Program. Someone from Foothill will present. (June)
- 3. Personal Statement workshop in August to 50-60 senior students. Approximately 10 students will attend Foothill College Fall 2017. Foothill may bring Outreach staff to College Track. (August)

Mellon Scholars Program update:

- The program will start Fall 2017. The Humanities Certificate (5 classes) has been approved and guarantees admission to USF.

- Minimum eligibility: 96 quarter units, 2.4 minimum GPA, priority to underrepresented students

- Must complete everything in 2 years
- Math 105 and ENGL 110
- Students that will be accepted: 35 @ FH and 35 @ DA for 70 total students
- Not sure how much money USF will give to students to cover tuition costs
- Students will be given a faculty mentor each quarter
- Students will be given an internships @ \$17/hour

- Humanities class textbooks will be free for students in program

- There will be stipends for faculty mentors

- Students will need to complete IGETC and other classes

- There isn't a humanities major/degree at USF. Students will have to major in English, Creative Writing, History, Philosophy, etc.

- Suggestions to program:

- 1) Educate students about Humanities and related careers
- 2) Recruit students from special programs

- Foothill does not have a dedicated Counselor. De Anza has a dedicated counselor.

Review Objectives/Reflections

- Promotional materials: Will get student feedback about promotional materials. So far we have ordered Transfer Awareness posters.

Transfer Center Update

- May is Transfer Awareness Month – We advertised events and activities through posters and classroom presentations.

- Cleve presented to the Foundation on March 22 and we presented to the Foothill Commission in April to bring awareness of our services and to address our funding needs.

Articulation & Honors Update:

- Honors Symposium at Stanford on May 6th, 2017

- COUN 8H course will focus on selective universities

- Concerns with curriculum unit creep and Honors courses

- General education patterns for 2017-2018 not approved by the state yet. They should be available around June 1^{st} .

- Assist next generation will be available soon.

- AB798: Beginning Jan 1, 2018 course schedules have to reflect when free textbooks are available online.

- Articulation/Evaluation/Curriculum looked at new AP policy. It will go into effect on July 1st. AP science can be used for major & general education.

- Honors have workshops on how to appeal universities if denied admission.

- AB 288: College and Career Pathways. TWG will invite Andrea from Marketing to discuss how we can support our local high schools regarding new community college legislation.

- A timeline is due in June for Law Pathways/Concurrent/dual Enrollment.
