

Foothill College Fall 2015 and 2016 Census Enrollment Comparisons Report

From Fall 2015 and Fall 2016:

- Enrollment
 - Resident and Non-Resident headcount are both down with Non-Resident down 5%.
 - Resident and Non-Resident FTES are both down with Non-Resident down 9%.
 - Overall, headcount decreased 201, which is a 1% decrease.
 - Overall, FTES decreased 126, which is a 4% decrease.

- International (F1) Students
 - Headcount among Fall 2016 F1/FC/FZ students is 1,004.
 - Male students represent more than half of the F1/FC/FZ enrollment (55%).
 - China (F16: 388; F15: 406), Hong Kong (F16: 81; F15: 104) and Indonesia (F16: 72; F15: 94) represent the top three countries of origin in Fall 2015 and Fall 2016.
- Student Ethnicity
 - Headcount among White (-241) and African American (-44) students declined between Fall 2015 and Fall 2016.
 - Headcount among Asian (+272), Filipino (+22), and Latino/a (+163) students increased between Fall 2015 and Fall 2016.

- Zip Code Grouping
 - Within Santa Clara County, headcount dropped by 296 students from Fall 2015 and Fall 2016, representing a 3% decline.

 - As a percentage of total headcount, students enrolled primarily from the immediate service area (Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos, Saratoga)—26%, and from San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward, East Palo Alto—30%.
