

## Foothill College Fall 2014 and Fall 2015 Census Enrollment Comparisons Report

From Fall 2014 to Fall 2015:

- Enrollment
  - Resident and non-resident estimated WSCH is down <1% at 156,973.
  - Total headcount is up 2% at 13,499.
  - Resident estimated WSCH is down <1% at 130,862.
  - Non-resident estimated WSCH is down <1% at 26,111.

- Online Learning
  - Total online learning estimated WSCH is up 3% at 48,883.
  - Online learning headcount is up 1% from 6,766 to 6,847.
  - Online learning enrollment is up 1% from 9,928 to 9,995.
  - Online learning sections offered is down 3% from 296 to 287.

- Student Ethnicity
  - Overall enrollment increased by 2% between Fall 2014 and Fall 2015.
  - Headcount from all ethnicities declined among African Americans (-89) and Whites (-66) but increased among Asians (+117), Latino/as (+255) and those who decline to state their ethnicity (+76).

  - Headcount from all ethnicities declined except among Latino/as (+111) and those who decline to state their ethnicity (+40).

- Student Population
  - The largest increase in headcount (3,120 to 3,286) and estimated FTES (+18) occurred among first time transfer students.
  - Enrollment among returning and continuing students from Fall 2014 and Fall 2015 each decreased in headcount while estimated FTES increased among returning students (+2%) and decreased among continuing students (-3%).

- Zip Code Grouping
  - Enrollment from all zip code groups increased from Fall 2014 to Fall 2015 except those from “San Jose Other, Santa Clara, Morgan Hill, Gilroy, Campbell” (-2%) and “Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos, Saratoga” (<1%).
  - The largest percentage of increase in the number of students enrolled from Fall 2014 to Fall 2015 were those from “All Other Areas” at 7%.

- Zip Code Grouping within Santa Clara County
  - Within Santa Clara County, African American student enrollment decreased by the largest percentage in “Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos, Saratoga” (19%) between Fall 2014 to Fall 2015 (136 to 110).
  - Within Santa Clara County, Filipino student enrollment increased by the largest percentage (17%) in “San Jose Other, Santa Clara, Morgan Hill, Gilroy, Campbell” between Fall 2014 to Fall 2015 (54 to 63).
  - Within Santa Clara County, Latino/a student enrollment increased by the largest percentage (12%) between Fall 2014 to Fall 2015 (1,032 to 1,151).

- International Students (F1)
  - Enrollment among F1 students increased from Fall 2014 to Fall 2015 by 6%, from 1,203 to 1,193.
  - Females represented 39% of all international students (F1 and FZ visa status) in Fall 2014 compared to 42% in Fall 2015.
  - In Fall 2014 and Fall 2015, the top three countries of origin for international students included China (F14: 371 vs. F15: 406), Hong Kong (F14: 143 vs. F15: 114) and Indonesia (F14: 139 vs. F15: 94).
  
- Applicants who Registered in Fall 2015
  - About one-quarter of the applicants who registered reported that they were never involved in activities that served their community in the past year (22%), which is down 1% from Fall 2014.
  - About one-quarter of the applicants who registered reported that they were first generation college students (27%), which is up 1% from Fall 2014.
  - Almost half of the applicants who registered reported that their family income over the past year was \$50,000 or less (45%), which is down 2% from Fall 2014.
  - A majority of the responses indicate that only English was spoken at home (70%).
  - Applicants who indicated they possessed language proficiency in languages other than English include: Spanish, Chinese, Vietnamese, Russian, and Farsi.
  - Almost half of the Fall 2015 applicants registered for the fall term (48%).
