RE: Biology Section Offerings

### Overview

Biology courses offered during 2010-11 and 2011-12 were identified and counted to determine how many sections were offered for each course. These numbers were summed and reported as an annual figure. In both years, the largest number of sections was offered in BIOL 40A, 10, 40B and 41. Overall, even with small changes in the number of sections offered by course, the total number of sections offered remained consistent at 167.
