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Integrated Reading and Writing (IRW) Cohort 2 Entrance Survey Results RE:

Overview

Students enrolled in the IRW program in Winter 2013 (ENGL 1S) were surveyed within the first three weeks of the quarter to capture student demographic information as well as student perceptions regarding their reading and writing abilities. Out of the 38 students enrolled as of January 14, 2013, 27 students completed the survey, reflecting a 71% response rate. Note that over one-third of students were previously enrolled in ENGL 209 (36%), 12 of whom enrolled in ENGL 209 in Fall 2012 (eight of these students successfully passed ENGL 209). Three students attempted ENGL 110 prior to their ENGL 1S enrollment, but none successfully passed ENGL 110. A majority of the students are continuing students (82%), while 13% are first-time students at Foothill College. While half of the ENGL 1S students are enrolled part-time this term, 42% are full-time, with 8% (3 students) having withdrawn from their courses by the eighth week.

Survey highlights:

- Almost one-third of survey respondents described themselves as Latino (30%).
- While one-third of the respondents are first generation college students, this category is primarily made up of Latinos (eight out of nine students).
- Among those students who indicated a major (89%), over one-third are majoring in the Biological and Health Sciences division (36%), about one-fifth are majoring in the Business and Social Sciences division (21%), and another 14% report majors housed in the Physical Sciences, Mathematics, and Engineering division.
- A majority of students expect to spend less than 10 hours per week on IRW class work outside of class (81%; 23 out of 28 students).
- Among those students expecting to spend less than 10 hours per week on IRW class work, 50% spend 20 hours or more per week on activities outside of school. Another 13% of students spend between 10 and 20 hours on activities outside of school.
- Less than one-third of the students self-report an above average rating in their reading ability or confidence; these students were more likely to report above average ability to perform skills or strategies related to reading and writing compared to the rest of their cohort.

- Students reported lower levels of writing confidence and ability compared to reading confidence and ability. No students reported being above average in their writing confidence and only 7% reported being above average in their writing ability. Roughly one-fifth reported being above average in their reading confidence and ability.
- The ability to complete the English requirement in two quarters was the top primary reason for enrolling in ENGL 1S (41%). The second primary reason was based on staff/counselor recommendation (37%). These findings support their goal of transferring to a 4-year college or university.

Methodology


The survey instrument contains 11 questions and administration of the online survey occurred in class. The number of potential respondents was determined by checking enrollment in course post-census date. Full-time status is enrollment in 12 units or more.





5. What is the highest level of formal education obtained by your parents/guardians?








c. Participating in college-sponsored activities


d. Providing care for others






8. How much time outside of class, on average, do you think you will need to spend on this class per week?

9. Outside of class assignments, how much do you read?






b. Reading ability






