

About the Survey

The CCSSE is a national survey instrument that was administered in-class to Foothill students and provides information on student engagement. The survey, administered to Community College students, asks specific questions that assess educational practices and student behaviors associated with higher learning, persistence and completion. Spring 2012 represented the first time Foothill College participated in this survey.

Face to face courses offered in spring 2012 were randomly sampled to participate in this survey. In the end, 43 sections participated, resulting in 948 valid responses.




- International students were overrepresented in the survey when compared to the overall student population (19% vs. 5%).
- White students were underrepresented in the survey when compared to the overall student population (29% vs. 42%).
- While almost two-thirds of respondents were between ages 18-24 (64%), less than half of the overall student population reflect the . same age range (40%).

- While full-time students made up the majority of survey respondents (66%) part-time students represent almost three-fourths of the . overall student population (73%).
- Responses by gender were representative of the overall student population, with females representing 53% of survey respondents. .


During the current school year, about how often have you done each of the following?




- Over half of the respondents very often or often worked on papers that required integrating ideas from various sources.
- 14% reported that they very often or often attended class with out completing readings or assignments.
- Nearly half (46%) of students reported that they often or very often worked harder than they thought they could to meet an instructor's standards.



How much does Foothill emphasize each of the following?



How much has your coursework at Foothill emphasized the following?




- Nearly two-thirds (64%) of respondents indicated Foothill contributed very much or quite a bit to their development to think critically/analytically and learn effectively on their own.
- Over half indicated Foothill as having contributed some or very little to the development of their mathematical skills and in making a contribution to the welfare of their community.

Student Experience at Foothill




How many hours do you spend in a typical 7-day week doing each of the following?

- Over one-third of students reported working more than 20 hours per week for pay.
- One-fifth of respondents indicated spending more than 10 hours per week caring for dependents.



More than one-third (43%) of the surveyed students report their educational experience at Foothill as excellent.
