- Zip Code Grouping
 - Enrollment from all zip code groups declined from Early Summer 2012 to Early Summer 2013 except those from All Other Areas (+24%).
 - The largest percentage of decrease in the number of students enrolled from Early Summer 2012 to Early Summer 2013 were those from San Mateo, Atherton, Redwood City, San Carlos, and Foster City at -17% (165 to 137).
 - The largest increase in the number of students enrolled from Early Summer 2012 to Early Summer 2013 was those from All Other Areas from 905 to 1,118.

- As a percentage of the total population, there was a 3-percentage point decrease from San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward and East Palo Alto (25% to 22%) and a 6-percentage point increase from All Other Areas (33% to 39%).
- As a percentage of the total population, there was no change in the rate of students from San Jose Other, Santa Clara, Morgan Hill, Gilroy, and Campbell, and San Mateo County Other between Early Summer 2012 and Early Summer 2013.

- City Grouping
 - Although students from San Jose continue to represent the largest group of students enrolled in Early Summer 2012 and Early Summer 2013, their enrollment did experience a percentage rate decrease (-7%).
 - Students from San Luis Obispo had the largest enrollment increase from Early Summer 2012 and Early Summer 2013 (54 to 131).
 - Cities outside Santa Clara and San Mateo counties that had enrollment over 20 students in Early Summer 2012 or Early Summer 2013 include: San Francisco, Fremont, San Diego, Hayward, Union City, Los Angeles and Santa Cruz.
