- Zip Code Grouping
  - Enrollment from all zip code groups declined from Fall 2011 to Fall 2012.
  - The largest percentage of decrease in the number of students enrolled from Fall 2011 to Fall 2012 were those from San Jose Other, Santa Clara, Morgan Hill, Gilroy and Campbell at -15% (1,178 to 1,001).
  - The largest decrease in the number of students enrolled from Fall 2011 to Fall 2012 were those from Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos and Saratoga from 4,497 to 3,847 (-14%).
