#### **Overview**

Students enrolled in at least one online course as of the Fall 2012 census were identified to determine the number of out-of-state students being served through this instructional method. There were 5620 and 3576 students enrolled in at least one online course at Foothill and De Anza respectively. Table 1 shows the number of out-of-state online course takers by campus, which comprises a very small percentage among all online course enrollment.

Table 1. FHDA Out-of-State Online Enrollment, Fall 2012.

Table 2 shows the time status of these out-of-state online students. Slightly less than half of these students are enrolled full-time (45%).

Oregon, Washington, Florida, and Virginia have the largest representation, representing 31% of all out-of-state online students (Table 3).
