

## Foothill College Fall 2012 and 2013 Census Enrollment Comparisons Report

From Fall 2012 and 2013:

- Enrollment
  - Resident and non-resident estimated WSCH is up 1% at 160,900.
  - Total headcount is down 2% at 1,828.
  - Resident estimated WSCH is down 3% at 135,018.
  - Non-resident estimated WSCH is up 9% at 25,883.

- Online Learning
  - Total online learning estimated WSCH is up 19% at 46,332.
  - Online learning headcount is up 15% from 5,630 to 6,477.
  - Online learning enrollment is up 16% from 8,394 to 9,713.
  - Online learning sections offered is up 16% from 243 to 281.

- Zip Code Grouping
  - Enrollment from all zip code groups declined from Fall 2012 to Fall 2013 except those from San Jose Other, Santa Clara, Morgan Hill, Gilroy, Campbell (1%) and All Other Areas (+13%).
  - The largest percentage of decrease in the number of students enrolled from Fall 2012 to Fall 2013 were those from Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos and Saratoga at -11% (4,680 to 4,188).
  - The largest increase in the number of students enrolled from last summer to this summer was those from All Other Areas from 2,262 to 2,563.

- As a percentage of the total population, there was a 3-percentage point decrease from Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos and Saratoga (35% to 32%), a 2-percentage point increase from All Other Areas (17% to 19%) and 1-percentage point increase from San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward, East Palo Alto.

- Student Population
  - The largest increase in headcount (1,864 to 2,512) and estimated FTES (4%) occurred among first time transfer students.
  - Enrollment among continuing students demonstrated the largest decline in both headcount (-11%) and estimated FTES (-7%) from Fall 2012 and Fall 2013.

- Student Ethnicity
  - Enrollment from all ethnicities between Fall 2012 and Fall 2013 declined except among those who decline to state their ethnicity (+1,433).
  - As a percentage of the total population, the largest decline by ethnicity by headcount and estimated FTES is among Whites (-7% and -4% respectively).

- International Students (F1)
  - Enrollment among F1 students increased from Fall 2012 and Fall 2013 by 1%, from 1,117 to 1,131.
  - Females represented 41% of all international students (F1 and FZ visa status) in Fall 2013 compared to 44% in Fall 2012.
  - In Fall 2013 and Fall 2012, the top three countries of origin for international students included China (328 F13 vs. 252 F12), Hong Kong (189 F13 vs. 245 F12) and Indonesia (149 F13 vs. 117 F12).

- Applicants and Enrollees
  - Roughly half of the applicants for Fall 2013 registered for Fall 2013 (51%).
