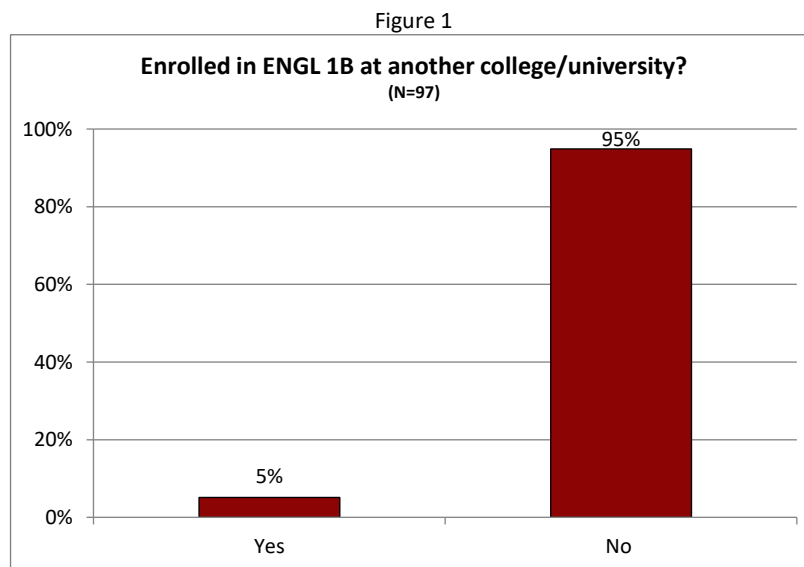

RE: Winter 2017 ENGL 1B Student Survey Results

Overview

Students who completed English 1A (grades A, B, C, or Pass) in fall 2016 at Foothill College, but did not enroll in English 1B or English 1BH in winter 2017 at Foothill College were surveyed to determine their reasons for not continuing with the course sequence. The online survey was administered on February 7 to February 17, 2017. A total of 260 students were invited to participate in the survey. These students include those who are not enrolled at Foothill for the winter 2017 quarter as well as those who are enrolled at Foothill for winter 2017 but not in English 1B/1BH. A total of 101 students completed the survey, for a response rate of 39%.

Enrolled in English 1B at Another College/University

- 95% (92) of respondents reported they are not enrolled in ENGL 1B at another college or university for the winter 2017 term.



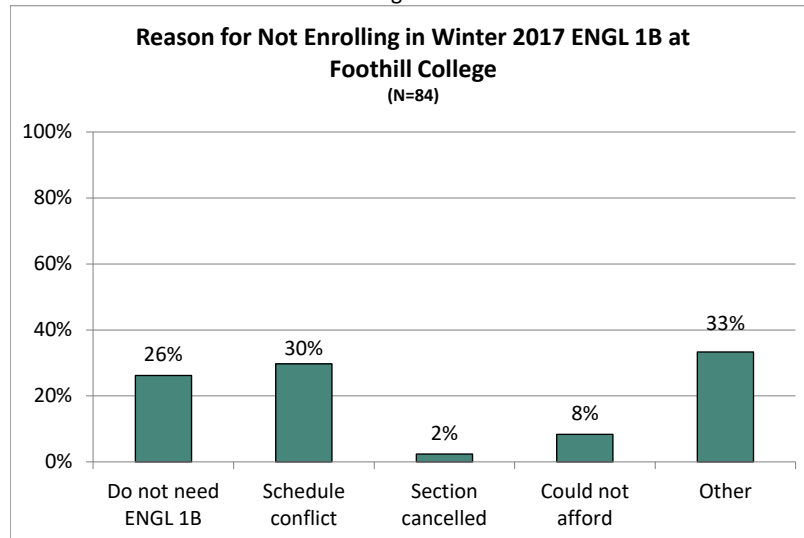
Four respondents did not answer this question.

Reason for Not Enrolling in English 1B at Foothill

- These 92 students were prompted to provide the reason they did not enroll in English 1B at Foothill College for the winter 2017 term.

- 26% (22) of respondents indicated they do not need ENGL 1B to satisfy a degree, certificate or transfer requirement
- 30% (25) of respondents indicated the course was offered on a day or time that did not fit with their schedule
- 33% (28) selected Other

Eight respondents did not answer this question.

- Among those who selected “Other,” they specified their reasons for not enrolling in English 1B at Foothill. Very few respondents cited personal reasons.
 - 25% (7) need a break from English and/or mention they plan to take it in the future
 - 22% (6) cited personal reasons (e.g. pregnancy, illness and inability to get to campus)
 - 18% (5) preferred a professor whose class they could not enroll in
 - 18% (5) indicated they wanted to focus on other classes

Plan to Enroll in English 1B at Foothill College Spring 2017¹

- 59% (41) plan to take ENGL 1B at Foothill in spring 2017
- 33% (23) might enroll
- 9% (6) do not plan to enroll

¹ N=70; two respondents did not answer this question. Students who indicated they are enrolled in English 1B at another college/university or do not need English 1B to satisfy a requirement are not included in this portion of the analysis.
