Information about transcript evaluations and transcript types

□ Schedule an Appointment with a Veterans Counselor

- Must complete a Veterans Education Plan for Veteran Educational Benefits
- Submit a Request for Enrollment Certification form AFTER you have met with the Veteran Resource Center Counselor

□ To Remain Eligible for Priority Registration, You Must:

- Declare a major and select a goal in My Portal
- Complete a New Student Orientation
- Have an education plan in DegreeWorks that includes classes for the quarter you want priority registration
- Meet the state requirements for priority registration (i.e. 2.0 GPA, less than 100 attempted credits)
